AUTHORIZED TESTING CENTER

In 2014, ICC Hawaii was recognized by Cambridge ESOL as an Authorized Centre for PET, FCE, CAE, and CPE Examinations.

In the first test of March 2015, ICC Hawaii received a 100% score from the Cambridge examiner and has maintained this high standard.

COURSE OPTIONS

FIRST CERTIFICATE OF ENGLISH (FCE)

LEVEL: *upper-intermediate English for general work or study*

Prepares you to talk to people about a wide variety of topics and understand spoken English from a variety of sources.

CERTIFICATE OF ADVANCED ENGLISH (CAE)

LEVEL: *advanced English for higher education and professional purposes*

Prepares you to take academic courses at the university level, communicate effectively at managerial and professional levels, and participate in workplace meetings and academic seminars.

CERTIFICATE OF PROFICIENCY IN ENGLISH (CPE)

LEVEL: *extremely advanced English for higher education and professional purposes (near native-speaker)*

Prepares you to excel at the highest levels of professional and academic life. Candidates learn to use English to advise or talk about complex or sensitive issues and understand the finer points of documents, correspondence, and reports.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

All applicants take a pre-test from which ICC Hawaii's Cambridge staff determines the appropriate level of the test prep course.

ICC Hawaii communicates the results and what it means for the student in considering the desired and best test preparation course.

More extensive testing takes place on the first day of class which yields information and that can confirm or disconfirm the pre-test and give the student more information on the appropriate level of course.

At each admission step, and as the courses progress, students are given assessments as to their potential to pass the actual test.

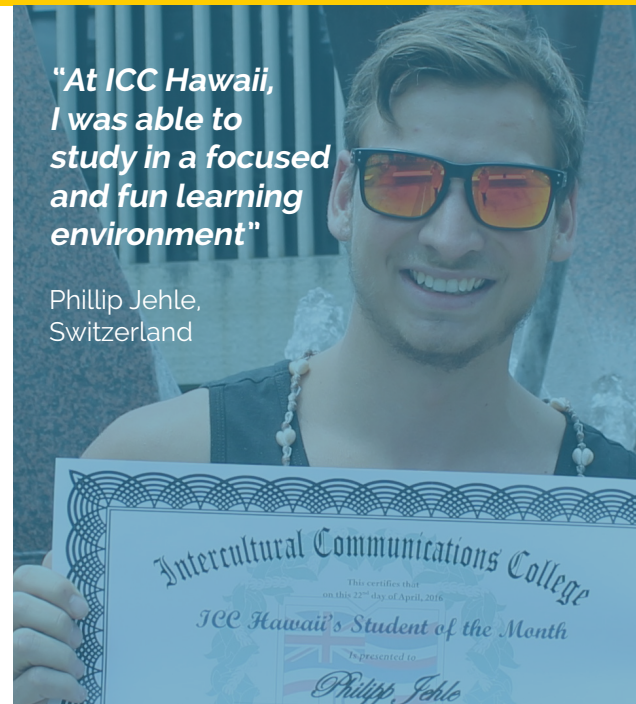
