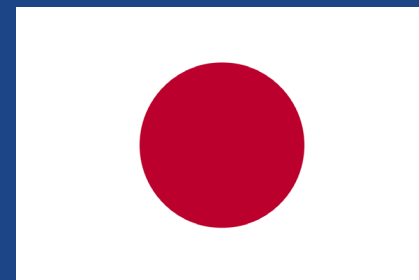
COURSE BACKGROUND
