

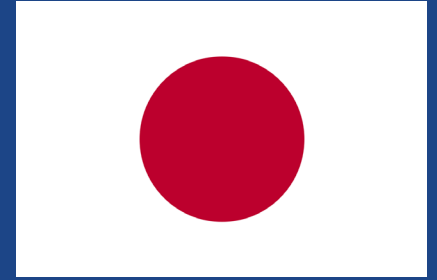
# FOREIGN LANGUAGE CLASSES
