

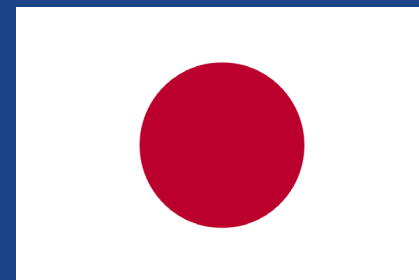
FOREIGN LANGUAGE CLASSES
